Dear Sisters and Brothers:

This is in reference to the vaccine mandate directive issued by Carrier to all employees on October 11, 2021. Over the past several days this office has received many calls and concerns from officers and members across our Committee. The purpose of this letter is to clarify the General Committee's role in this dispute.

The General Committee holds authority to negotiate and enforce collective bargaining agreements and related issues. The Committee cannot enforce or interpret laws or other legal or constitutional matters. Regardless, Carrier's actions are viewed as a change in working conditions and this Committee will defend our member's rights under the agreements to the fullest extent of our authority.

This position was conveyed to Labor Relations in a letter earlier today. In that letter, this Committee, as well as most other General Committees on Carrier's properties, demanded that Carrier cease and desist from its current action against the membership. We also demanded that changes of this nature be negotiated between the parties and until such time, the status quo must be maintained. Carrier's response will be forwarded when it is received.
